Mr. Duncan called the meeting to order at 10:17 a.m. All documents referenced in the minutes are filed in the Commissioners’ office and are available for review upon request.


NOTE Brad Roades, and Caitlin Forsha were present for the meeting.




EMERGENCY MEETING

Commissioners met during an emergency meeting to discuss the upcoming 2023 budgets. Commissioner Britton started out by saying that we had been working on budgets for two months or more and wanted to thank Commissioner Clerks Ashleigh Willey and Mary Remsing, along with Nicole Oberrecht. He explained that normally they access wage increases according to the economy and cost of living. This year though, it is not feasible to do that with cost of living being up 8-9%. With that being said, he proposed a \$1.00/hr. wage increase across the board. Commissioner Daniels agreed with that and said he thought it was the most economically beneficial thing to do at this time.

MOTION Mr. Daniels moved, seconded by Mr. Duncan to approve the \$1.00/hr. wage increase. The vote resulted as follows: Mr. Duncan yea; Mr. Britton, yea; Mr. Daniels, yea.
