<b>Lynchburg</b>	Main St. near Bobbitt St. (near Dollar General) Terry's Grocery/Marathon Station - 1505 US 50
<b>Marshall</b>	Mini Mart/Marathon Station - 11070 SR 506 (at Route 124)
<b>Mowrystown</b>	Old Feed Mill - 106 W. Main St. (across from Crop Production Services)
<b>New Market</b>	Food Mart/Gas Station - 5828 W. New Market Rd (at US 62)
<b>Paint Township Buildings</b>	- 12470 US 50 (Rocky Fork Lake Region near Route 753)

### **DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC GROCERY BAGS OR PLASTIC TRASH BAGS IN THE BINS...REUSE THEM!**

The following items can be placed in the recycling bins: plastic bottles and jugs (with a BASE that is larger than its opening), glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans and lids, office paper and envelopes, junk mail, newspapers and inserts, magazines, telephone books, catalogs, paperboard, cartons and cardboard. **Please flatten all boxes to save space in the bins.** Rumpke collects all of the recyclables from the bins and sorts them at their facilities.

Highland County is part of the Ross-Pickaway-Highland-Fayette Solid Waste District which provides funding for the county recycling program under the guidance of the [Ohio Environmental Protection Agency](#). The District has a board of directors and a policy committee who develop a plan of operation for the district that includes a recycling program. The District's funds allotted to each county are used to hire a Recycling Outreach Specialist to coordinate all the recycling activities including bin location and monitoring.
