Gathers data to evaluate and assess students to determine functional and developmental needs and develops Individual Education Plan(s) based on the evaluation team report (ETR). Follows and utilizes Individual Educational Plans for those students (i.e., 3 to 5 years of age) identified and assigned for instruction.

Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education or related field and a Pre-K teaching license from ODE plus (1) year experience working with Step Up To Quality in a DD preschool or related field preferred. You must possess or be willing to obtain and maintain [Intervention Specialist](#) or [Prekindergarten Endorsement](#) certification from [Ohio Department of Education](#) as well as CPR and First Aide certification.
