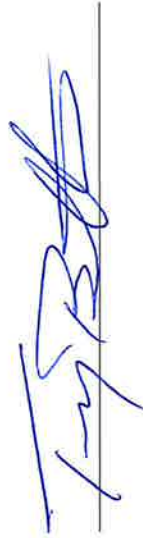
- Commissioners discussed the relocation of the Court House offices during the Renovation.
