

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NO. 2
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
HIGHLAND COUNTY, OHIO**

Highland County has received notice from the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development (OCD) indicating that it has been allocated \$228,000 under the PY2026 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Allocation Program, a federally funded program administered by the State. These funds are available to Highland County provided it meets applicable requirements. On February 24, 2026, a general public hearing was held at the Commissioners' Office to inform citizens about this and other programs, how funds may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements. Based upon both public input and local officials' assessment of need, Highland County will submit a PY2026 CDBG Application for the following activities:
